

India Lands On The Moon

India's biggest occasion to celebrate this year came on August 23 when it entered the elite space club by successfully landing on the moon. India

became the fourth country to make a moon landing and the first to land a spacecraft on the lunar south pole. The success of Chandrayaan-3 was celebrated across the country. Prime



Minister Modi has described India's moon touchdown as "one of the most inspiring moments of this century".



In a giant leap for its space programme, India's Moon mission Chandrayaan-3 touched down on the lunar south pole on Wednesday, propelling the country to an exclusive club of four and making it the first country to land on the uncharted surface.

India Hosts G20 Summit

Delhi decked up in its finest as India played host to leaders from across the world during the G20 summit on September 9-10,2023. Roads were spruced up, fountains installed and pavements revamped as the national



capital underwent a makeover ahead of the big meet.

Among the key outcomes of the summit was the inclusion of African Union into the grouping. The Global Biofuel Alliance, a move towards adopting sustainable biofuels, was also

launched. The big takeaway for India was the agreement on an economic corridor linking India, Gulf countries and Europe.

The theme of India's G20 Presidency - "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" or "One Earth \cdot One Family \cdot One Future" - was drawn from the ancient Sanskrit text of the Maha Upanishad. Essentially, the theme affirms the value of all life — human, animal, plant, and microorganisms — and their interconnectedness on the planet Earth and in the wider universe.

The theme also focused on (Lifestyle for Environment), with its associated, environmentally sustainable and responsible choices, both at the level of individual lifestyles as well as national development, leading to globally transformative actions resulting in a cleaner, greener and bluer future.

India Shines In World Cup, Falters In Final

The men's Cricket World Cup this year saw India put up a stellar show with an undefeated streak through 11 matches. Our World Cup campaign, however, ended in disappointment, with Australia taking home the trophy after prevailing over the men in blue in the final. There

IFFI: Michael Douglas awarded Satyajit Ray lifetime achievement award

Cinema is one of the few mediums with the power to unite people, Hollywood star Michael Douglas said after receiving the Satyajit Ray Lifetime Achievement Award at



the closing ceremony of the International Film Festival of India (IFFI) here on Tuesday (28th Nov 2023). The 10-day film gala concluded with *Endless Borders* from Germany winning the coveted Golden Peacock Award for the best film, while Deepak Kumar Mishradirected Prime Video show *Panchayat* season two bagged the best OTT series award, which was introduced for the first time.

Goa Chief Minister Pramod Sawant felicitated Mr. Douglas with the Satyajit Ray Lifetime Achievement Award at the ceremony. The veteran actor, known for movies *Wall Street, Fatal* Attraction, *The War of the Roses, Basic Instinct, The*

American President, highlighted cinema's role in promoting "our shared humanity".

The 79-year-old actor said Satyajit Ray was a world-class filmmaker who represented not only the triumphs of the Indian film industry, but also the "cross-cultural artistic expression".

"It's an honour to stand before all of you tonight and receive this. I am humbled to join a prestigious group of past award recipients," Mr. Douglas said.

IIT Madras establishes first international campus in Tanzania's Zanzibar

The Indian Institute of Technology Madras became the first Indian Institute of Technology to set up an international campus, by launching a campus in Tanzania on Monday. India and the East African nation had recently signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU).

Zanzibar and Chairman of the Revolutionary Council, inaugurated the IIT Madras Zanzibar at an event held on Monday at the Zanzibar campus in the presence of Tanzanian officials, Indian dignitaries, faculty, and students.

Initially, the Institute will offer BS and MTech programmes in Data Science and Artificial Intelligence. More academic programmes will be offered in the coming year. In the first batch at IITM Zanzibar, students from Zanzibar, mainland Tanzania, Nepal, and India have been admitted, with 40 per cent of the students being women.

The programmes at IITM Zanzibar are open to students of all nationalities, including Indians. Apart from a comprehensive curriculum that includes all aspects of Data Science and Artificial Intelligence, students will have access

to several

Australia, among other countries, internships with various relevant companies, and a chance to meet some of the course requirements at the IIT Madras campus in Chennai, India. Classes for the first Academic Year (2023-24) commenced in October 2023.


Breaking barriers: Parliament passes Women's reservation bill

"A defining moment in our nation's democratic journey," Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on September 22 as Rajya Sabha passed the historic women's reservation bill with 214 MPs voting in favour and none against. The 'Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam' became the first bill to be passed by Parliament after it shifted to the new building on Tuesday.

On 21 September 2023, Indian legislators passed the first legislation considered in the country's new Parliament building: the Women's Reservation Bill, 2023. The bill, which passed both houses of Parliament almost unanimously—with just two votes against—will ensure that

women occupy at least 33 per cent of the seats in state legislative assemblies and the Lok Sabha. the lower house of Parliament.

The Women's Reservation Bill, often referred to as the Women's



Reservation Bill, is a proposed piece of legislation in India aimed at increasing the representation of women in the Indian Parliament and State Legislative Assemblies. The bill seeks to reserve a certain percentage of seats in these legislative bodies exclusively for women. The proposed legislation, known as the Constitution (One Hundred and Eighth Amendment) Bill of 2008, aims to set aside a third of the seats in the Lok Sabha and state legislative assemblies for women.


The distribution of these reserved seats will be decided by the authority designated by Parliament. Additionally, one-third of the seats reserved for **Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes** in the Lok Sabha and legislative assemblies will be specifically allocated to women from these groups. These reserved seats may be rotated among various constituencies within the state or union territory.

The bill's objective is to promote gender equality in the political sphere and empower women to actively participate in the democratic process. However, its passage into law has been a subject of ongoing debate and discussion in India's political landscape.

India in space: Isro successfully launches its solar mission

On 2nd September 2023, Isro's Aditya-L1 mission was launched. It is

India's first mission dedicated to studying the Sun, specifically the photosphere, chromosphere, and corona of Sun. It has 7 distinct payloads developed, all developed indigenously. Five by Isro and two by



academic institutes in collaboration with the space agency.

Aditya-L1 is India's first solar mission of observatory-class, which is

designed for study of the sun. The spacecraft will be positioned in a halo orbit around the Lagrangian point1 (L1) of the Sun-Earth system, which is approximately 1.5 million km from earth, for ensuring continuous, unobstructed solar observation. The spacecraft is carrying seven payloads for scrutinizing the photosphere, chromosphere, and the Sun's outer



layers (corona) through electromagnetic and particle detectors. Positioned at L1, four payloads will observe the Sun directly, while the other three conduct studies of particles and fields. Aditya L1's suite aims to yield vital insights into coronal heating, Coronal Mass Ejection, flare activities, space weather dynamics, particle propagation, and interplanetary medium characteristics




